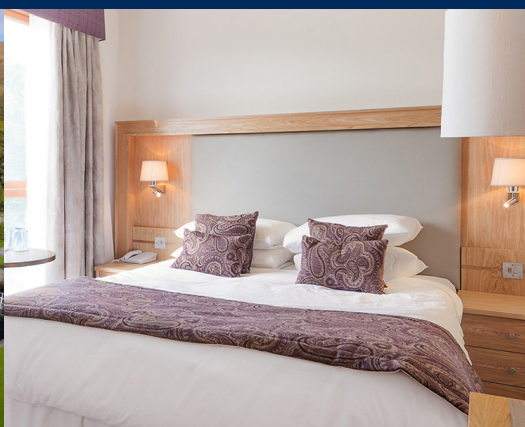

Set on the banks of the Caledonian Canal, featuring Neptune's Staircase, a historic Landmark designed by Thomas Telford in the early 1800's, this tranquil and picturesque location provides the perfect base for your visit to the West Coast of the Scottish Highlands. Known for its breathtaking scenery and known widely as the Outdoor Capital of the UK, Fort William and Lochaber is bursting with history, wildlife, outdoor activities and culture.

The hotel itself is in a canalside location featuring a cafe/ bistro, decking area, patio area & gardens, gym, large function suite, as well as 32 well appointed en-suite bedrooms decorated to a very high standard. Our Caledonian Function Suite seats up to 120 people and features a large dance floor, perfect should you wish to enjoy some Traditional Scottish music, which we can also help you to arrange.

The hotel offers a range of standard, superior and executive rooms featuring their very own balcony overlooking Ben Nevis and the Caledonian Canal. All rooms are tastefully furnished and individually designed, with private en-suite bathrooms, hospitality trays, hairdryers, free high speed WiFi, complimentary water, TV and a selection of quality complimentary toiletries.

Attractions & Points of Interest Close By:

Nevis Range

Britain's only Mountain Gondola, High Wire Adventure, Bike and Walking Tracks & Snowsports Resort - Nevis Range, Aonach Mor – approx 7 miles.

Ben Nevis Distillery

One of Scotland's oldest distilleries and the creator of the local well known whisky – Ben Nevis.
Daily Tours Available. – approx 1 mile.

Crannog Cruises

Wildlife Tours on Loch Linnhe. Sailings Daily – Fort William – approx 3 miles.

Treasures of the Earth

Europe's finest private collection of Crystals, Gemstones and Fossils. Open Daily. – Corpach – approx 1.5 miles.

Ben Nevis & Glen Nevis Visitor Centre

Britain's highest mountain and information centre – Glen Nevis – approx 4 miles.

The Caledonian Canal

Situated right next to the hotel, runs from Corpach, Fort William in the West Coast to Inverness, in the East Coast, for some 60 miles. It was constructed in the early 19th century by engineer, Thomas Telford. Only 1/3 of the canal is man-made with the rest made up of Loch Dochfour, Loch Ness, Loch Oich, and Loch Lochy. Neptune's Staircase is located right outside the hotel and consists of 8 Locks lifting boats some 64 ft. It is the longest system in Britain and takes on average around 90 minutes to pass through.

Deposits

- A 25% deposit is required within 6 weeks of making a reservation for all group bookings. This deposit is refundable up to 12 weeks prior to arrival.

Numbers

- Provisional group numbers are required 12 weeks prior to arrival, numbers must be reviewed, and a provisional rooming list, and update, sent to the hotel group reservation manager.
- Final rooming lists and numbers are required 6 weeks prior to the groups' arrival.

Final Payment

- The remaining balance must be paid within 6 weeks prior to the groups' arrival and is non refundable.
- The Hotel reserves the right to cancel and resell any bookings not paid as detailed above on the relevant dates.
- Failure to provide payments and numbers on time could result in the booking being cancelled and the deposit retained.

Single Occupancy & Rates

- A maximum of 2 single rooms will be allowed at the single occupancy rate. Any extra single rooms required, over and above 2, will be charged at full B & B occupancy unless otherwise agreed by the hotel in writing prior to arrival and written into the group Terms and Conditions.

Porterage

- Arrival and Departure times must be confirmed with the hotel 2 weeks prior to arrival.
- If the client requires Porterage this should be arranged, no less, than 6 weeks prior to arrival and will be charged at an extra cost of £ 1.50 per guest.
- Please be aware if porterage is not pre-booked we cannot guarantee this will be available on arrival and departure of the group.

Dining Information

- The Hotel must be made aware of any special dietary requirements of the client at least 2 weeks prior to arrival
- Breakfast consists of a continental and full Scottish Breakfast
- Dinner will be a 3 course set menu, unless agreed previously with the hotel.
